GENERAL GUIDELINES

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- All the abstracts submitted have to be presented for a poster the days of the meeting.
- One poster session will take place during the meeting, during the lunch time.
- Poster boards are **115cm wide and 157cm high**. Not the inverse
- **A quick presentation** will be done by each presenting author during the POSTER'S TEASER. You will have 1 minute and 1 slide to present your poster. **The slide should be send to scientific@arsep.org before the deadline.**

INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

- The abstract should be in English and joined to the registration form.
- The abstract should be send ONLY by the PRESENTING AUTHOR and NOT by the co-authors, even if the presenting author is not the 1st author.
- **Abstracts must not exceed one page (format A4) with "arial" font, size 11 and interline 1.**

PRIZES FOR YOUNG RESEARCHERS

- A prize of 1 500 € for the best poster will be awarded.
- A prize of 1 500 € for the best teaser will be awarded.

TRAVEL GRANTS FOR YOUNG RESEARCHERS

- ARSEP Foundation offers meeting "travel grants" to help young researchers to defray the costs of their travel expenses to reach Paris and their accommodation for one night.
- Selected researchers will be refunded on presentation of travel tickets and invoices. The reimbursement may not exceed 400 €. Travel should be done in the economic class. The hotel should not be more than 2 **.
- The number of travel grants will be dependent on the resources available to the Foundation.

Requirements for the application are as follows

- Candidates must follow a Ph. D scientific program or a post-doctoral course.
- They must be under 40 years old.
- Applicants must submit a poster as first author and presented it on the day of the meeting.
- Applicants must send a CV with their abstract.
